Appealing the Board of Elevator Regulations' decision to deny a variance, for a variance from 524cmr 35.00 Section 2.26, specifically from FS90 work through June 2025, as the elevator will be decommissioned.

Steve Femino explained that the Board of Elevator Regulations (BER) denied the petition for a variance VAR24-0006 for a waiver of having to do FS90 work through June 2025, stating that the permits for FS90 repairs had not been submitted as required by previous testing and notifications with no demonstration of hardship by the owner. He indicated that the elevator is currently used by one handicapped student, the staff and guests and that there are two means of egress.

Paul Haughey, the superintendent of the Spencer school district, indicated that they were not ignoring the issue but were using the extensions allowed and that he was unaware that the extensions would stop before the elevator would be decommissioned. And stated that he was trying to not add the additional cost of the required FS90 repairs to the school district, due to spending restrictions.

After a discussion by the board, the petitioner was directed to provide additional information to the Board by March 21, 2024, including the following:

- a. A progress plan for the new school.
- b. Information regarding the stop switch in the current elevator, including whether it is keyed, push-pull, or toggle. Please include a current photograph of the car operating panel.
- c. Signed letter from local Fire Chief indicating local fire department's view on
 - i. FS-90 noncompliance for this elevator; and
 - ii. whether firefighters would in fact use this elevator in this building.

Paul Haughey requested the information in writing, to which he was informed that the information would be submitted to the petitioner in the form of an email, which was done on March 7, 2024. This hearing was concluded at 9:49 a.m.
