### DECISION

Phat Al's Inc. dba Becket General Store (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 16, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34c. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Michael Teehan's Compliance Check Field Report.

#### **FACTS**

- 1. On, June 7, 2011 at approximately 7:41 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation of Phat Al's Inc. dba Becket General Store.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a can of Bud Light for one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

#### CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34c. The Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
