### DECISION

# MUSTARD GREEN INC. D/B/A ASIANA BISTRO 200 THE GREAT ROAD, UNIT #1A-2B BEDFORD, MA 01730 LICENSE#: 008200019 VIOLATION DATE: 03/28/2016 HEARING DATE: 05/31/2016

Mustard Green Inc. d/b/a Asiana Bistro (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, May 31, 2016, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) -Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 - Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Kujawski's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report dated March 28, 2016; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.
- A. Licensee's TIPS Certification.

## **FACTS**

- 1. On Monday, March 28, 2016, at approximately 7:48 p.m., Investigators Di Cicco and Kujawski investigated the business operation of Mustard Green Inc. d/b/a Asiana Bistro.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser Light beer, for four dollars and one cent (\$4.01). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

#### <u>CONCLUSION</u>

Based on the evidence the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) -Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
