- 1. Call to Order at 9:07a.m.
- 2. Approval of Draft Meeting Minutes from May 6, 2020-Walter Zalenski made a motion to accept the minutes as read. George Dahlquist seconded the motion. **All in Favor 5-0.**
- 3. Approval of Elevator Mechanic Applications-Jeff Halley reviewed the following applications with the Board; Derek Curr, Robert Kiggen, Christopher Martin, Chris McDavid, Kyle Moran, Glenn Perry, Christopher Praster and Kwame Rhodes. Walter Zalenski made a motion to accept the applications, George Dahlquist seconded. All in Favor 5-0.
- 4.
