D.E.P. Ram Corp. d/b/a Town Mart (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, February 25, 2020, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Watson's Report.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, August 7, 2019, at approximately 9:09 p.m., Investigators Temple and Watson ("Investigators") conducted an investigation of the business operation of D.E.P. Ram Corp. d/b/a Town Mart.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, for three dollars (\$3.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. The Licensee informed the Commission at the hearing that they have a policy to ask for identification of anyone who appears to be under 35 years of age.

4. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2007 with no prior violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. The Commission issues a **WARNING**.
