**SHREE YAMUNAVALLABH GROUP BELCHERTOWN
D/B/A YE OLDE GROG SHOPPE

Shree Yamunavallabh Group Belchertown d/b/a Ye Olde Grog Shoppe (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, January 28, 2020, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Watson's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

 2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact;
 3. Copy of Transfer Application Approval, 10/20/2011;
 4. Beneficial Interest Summary Report, 2/18/2019.

FACTS

1. On Wednesday, August 7, 2019, at approximately 8:41 p.m., Investigators Temple and Watson ("Investigators") conducted an investigation of the business operation of Shree Yamunavallabh Group Belchertown d/b/a Ye Olde Grog Shoppe.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, for two dollars and ninety cents (\$2.90). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2011 with no prior violations.

CONCLUSION

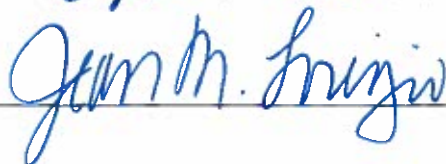
Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. The Commission issues a **WARNING**.
