Jay Jalaram Bapa Corporation (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 23, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Mark Kenny's Compliance Check Field Report.

- 3. The Investigators then approached the individual and asked for identification.
- 4. The individual provided a valid MA driver license indicating that he was under twenty-one (21) years of age.
- 5. The underage individual showed Investigators a fake Rhode Island Driver's License and stated he used the fake license to purchase the alcohol.
