The petitioner was before the board on June 3, 2025, and March 4, 2025, seeking a variance from ASME A18.1 2014 section 3.1.2.2 for overhead clearance to install new lift to replace the existing lift. The board voted to extend the original 60 day hold by an additional 60 days, which will be a deadline of August 4, 2025, to provide additional documentation.

51 Woodbeck Ridge Rd Sheffield New Installation Code Reference: ASME A18.1-2014; Section 2.1.1.7 Petitioner: Paul Farnsworth

The petitioner is seeking relief from ASME A18.1-214; Section 2.1.1.7 as the proposed Residential Vertical Platform Lift "VPL" does not comply with the current edition of the Massachusetts Code (ASME A18.1-2014). But to allow the proposed VPL to be installed as it is in full compliance with the latest edition of ASME A18.1-2023- Safety Standard for Platform Lifts and Stairway Chairlifts. The board voted to place the item on a 60-day hold, which will be a deadline of August 4, 2025, to provide additional documentation.

The petitioner is seeking relief from A17.1-2013, code section 2.11.10.1.1 metal fascia requirement seeking to substitute with a laminated safety glass that is stamped "laminated safety glass AS-2". It has the exact same characteristics as the laminated safety glass requiring the Z97.1. The board voted to place the item on a 60-day hold, which will be a deadline of August 4, 2025, to provide additional documentation.

e. VAR25-0017

New Installation Code: ASME A 18.1 2014 - 5.1.6 Headroom Clearance Petitioner: Michelle Ouellette

The petitioner seeks variance from ASME A 18.1 2014 - 5.1.6 Headroom Clearance for the installation of a vertical platform lift in a single-family home. The home is historic with a difficult to adjust slate roof and limited 2nd floor ceiling height. The location selected is the best available, but a portion of the platform has a head clearance of less than 79". The board voted to place the item on a 60-day hold, which will be a deadline of August 4, 2025, to provide additional documentation.
