4. Next, the Board continued discussion regarding a possible safety/code issue for emergency services utilizing Fireman's Service Phase II. The Board discussed the code compliance of the Otis/Motion jump car switch. Phase II. The Board mentioned that Otis deactivates the function of the doors when code requires the doors to close. The Acting Chair referenced Section 2.27.31.16 2004 where it reads "fire recall" and explained the importance of switch functions. Mr. Morgan and Mr. Mullane agreed about Otis not following code requirements. In referencing the 1996 edition, Otis' control is a "clear violation" according to the Acting Chair. Dave Morgan in agreement

Next, the Board discussed the A.17.1 1996 code interpretation and referred to an email from Debbie Prince of Motion Control Engineering dated 1/18/2022 [Exhibit 4]. The

Board agreed that the door operation is non-compliant and that the stop switch doesn't respond to fire fighter's commands. The Acting Chair suggested a plan with a deadline to require corrections to fix the stop switches be created. The Board suggested drafting a written response with a deadline for completion for Elevator Contractors and equipment owners. Manufacturers and the Fire Department should be notified as well. A motion was made by David Morgan to request counsel to draft a response and share at the next meeting. Motion was seconded by Christopher Towski.
