Peter Kelley Ruthy Barros The petitioner appeared before the Board Petitioner is seeking a variance from 524 CMR "Top of car space". Mr. Fahey went over the submission variance packet, stating that the existing unit is a Motion Control Elevator, hydraulic, two-stop, twin hole less, installed approximately on May 30, 1997. An incident occurred on January 28, 2022, and the unit was shut down by OPSI and failed the placard removal inspection on February 8, 2022 and removed shut down. Included in the submission was a copy of a Shutdown Notice issued on February 8, 2022, by an OPSI Elevator Inspector. Mr. Fahey stated he is seeking a variance from the citation, "No refuge spaces on top of car A17-1996 300.8d between cross head and top of hoistway". The MBTA is proposing to put high visibility signage and warning labels on the elevator car top, in the elevator hoistway and in the elevator machine room, stating "Caution Low Overhead Clearance". OPSI included pictures of the existing hoistway condition [Exhibit 1A], which illustrated a portion of the hoistway chipped out. Mr. Fahey stated that Kone could remove the bolts in the overhead by grinding them out. Mr. Morse stated that he does not believe a variance is required because the code is met other than the cartop light socket, which can be moved by agreement of the owners. A motion was made by David Morgan to allow the petitioner to withdraw their variance request based on the fact that the elevator, as installed, could be made code compliant. Justification being the safety of mechanics working on the elevator. The motion was seconded by David Gaudet.
