Regular time rates apply when service is performed on weekdays (Mon-Fri) between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm.

Overtime rates apply when service is requested by the shipper to be performed on weekdays (Mon-Fri) between the hours of 5:00pm and 8:00am and all day on Saturday.

Time is computed from the time vehicle and helpers report at the original point of loading until the completion of unloading the last load at final destination, less time spent for meals or vehicle breakdown, plus an added charge for each vehicle and all helpers used, to cover running time which shall not be assessed more than once during any one day to the same shipper for the same vehicle as stated below:

Based on the distance between the original point of loading and final point of unloading in accordance with odometer readings:

UP TO AND INCLUDING 5 MILES-----	ADD ½ HOUR
6-15 MILES -----	ADD 1 HOUR
16-25 MILES -----	ADD 1 ½ HOURS
26-35 MILES -----	ADD 2 HOURS
36-50 MILES-----	ADD 2 ½ HOUR

DEFINITION- The term "Household goods and Furniture" as used in this tariff means: The transportation of furniture and household goods in whole or in part incident to a move by a householder to or from a dwelling and a storage warehouse; or from one dwelling to another.

Estimates/quotations – Carrier cannot quote a firm price on a move from a residence or establishment to another if a public way has to be used by a vehicle. He may give a written estimate, but in doing so be qualified to estimate within twenty-five (25%) of the actual charges. The final charges to be assessed shall be in accordance with actual tariff rates.



Rates in this Section apply to all shipments not provided for in time basis rates. Rates are in dollars and cents per 100 pounds applied to actual weight (subject to a minimum weight as provided in rules herein). They include loading and unloading and the actual movement or transportation of property from origin to destination, but do not include Additional Services and Charges shown in this tariff. Rates will be calculated from origin, via points of extra pickup or delivery, to destination and will apply to total weight. Break point indicates weight at which a lower charge develops by use of lowest weight and applicable rate in next higher weight bracket.

BETWEEN: Woods Hole, MA	PER	RATE
Martha's Vineyard Island	100 pounds	\$9.00
Nantucket Island	100 pounds	\$13.00

Note 1: A minimum charge based on a minimum weight of 5,000 lbs. will apply on shipments transported to and from Islands named.

Note 2: The above rates include all transportation charges between Woods Hole dock and the Islands.

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Each elevator charge \$2.40 per 100 pounds

Each flight charge \$2.40 per 100 pounds

Excessive distance --every 50' after the first 75', \$2.40 each 50' or portion of it.



### PACKING SERVICES

1. Rates include packing, the use of packing containers and materials, unpacking. No additional hourly rates shall be charged for the personnel performing such service.
2. Packing rates include only the packing services of carrier furnished containers.
3. Unpacking includes unpacking service of containers furnished and packed by carrier and disposal of such containers and materials if requested by consignee. Unpacking service, if ordered, must be performed at time of delivery unless consignee request otherwise. If consignee request that unpacking of carrier packed items be performed subsequent to the time of delivery, the carrier's hourly labor rates will apply.
4. Rates shown apply to regular time packing and unpacking. Rates will increase by an additional 20% when packing or unpacking service is performed between the hours of 5:00pm and 8:00am, Monday thru Friday or anytime on Saturday. Rates will increase by an additional 40% if packing or unpacking services is performed on holidays or Sundays.

Note 1: Cubical content must be shown on all cartons

Note 2: In the event that two or more standard containers must be joined together because of the size, shape or character of the item or items to be packed, the charge shall be the combined charge reflected in this item.

### CRATING SERVICES

\$12.00 per cuft.

EXAMPLE: 36"W X 36"D X 36"H

$$36 \times 36 \times 36 = 46,656 \text{ CU/IN}$$

$$46,656 / 1728 \text{ CU/IN} = 27 \text{ CUFT}$$

$$27\text{CUFT} \times \$12/\text{CUFT} = \$324.00$$

$$6\text{'D} \times 32\text{'W} \times 48\text{'H} = 9,216 \text{ CU/IN}$$

$$9,216 / 1728 \text{ CU/IN} = 5.33 \text{ CUFT}$$

$$5.33\text{CUFT} \times \$12/\text{CU/FT} = \$64.00$$
