



Notice of Intent to Award Funds to the Massachusetts Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (MCDHH)

The Massachusetts Office for Victim Assistance intends to award approximately \$300,000 in federal Antiterrorism Emergency Assistance Grant funds (AEAP) to the Massachusetts Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (MCD). The funds will be utilized for the purpose of providing services for Marathon survivors and their families.

MCD will work to ensure a broad spectrum of services including audiograms, comprehensive evaluations, Assistive Hearing Services and Technology and long term guidance are provided to the Boston Marathon Bombing survivors' acute, untreated, hearing loss population.

The MCD has the statutory authority to provide these services under M.G.L. c(9), Sec. 191-197. This Best Value award will enable the MCD to continue to effectively provide services to Marathon Bombing Victims and meet its legislative requirements.

Funding will support services from ISA execution through June 30, 2015.
