DECISION

TRATTORIA BELLAMIA INC. D/B/A TRATTORIA BELLAMIA

218 CABOT STREET BEVERLY, MA 01915 LICENSE#: 010000058

VIOLATION DATE: 08/17/2016 HEARING DATE: 05/24/2017

Trattoria Bellamia Inc. d/b/a Trattoria Bellamia (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Wednesday, May 24, 2017, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Doyle's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Investigator Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report dated August 17, 2016.
- A. Middlesex Probate and Family Court Letter of Authority for Personal Representative.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, August 17, 2016, at approximately 5:55 p.m., Investigators Bailey and Doyle ("Investigators") investigated the business operation of Trattoria Bellamia Inc. d/b/a Trattoria Bellamia.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser Light beer, for three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the Licensee has had no prior violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
