- 1. Mary Ann Smith, DFS Staff, provided an update on the NEC 70, 2026 review. The Massachusetts Electrical Advisory Committee had their first meeting on September 24, 2025. The NEC 70, 2026 hard copy will be available the first week of October for members.

The BFPR will schedule a meeting mid October to accelerate promulgating the 527 CMR 1.00 based off NFPA 1, 2024 edition.
