## **DECISION**

Mass. Foods, Corp. dba Garrison's (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, August 14, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Bailey's Compliance Check Field Report.

## **FACTS**

- 1. On Monday, May 14, 2012 at approximately 6:35 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Bailey conducted an investigation of the business operation of Mass. Foods, Corp. dba Garrison's.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Bud Light beer for three dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
