BIPOC experience unique generational trauma from racial oppression, leading to specific mental health needs. Research shows that racism is associated with poor mental health and its lasting physical effects. BIPOC also disproportionately experience disability resulting from mental disorders.

However, there are several barriers preventing BIPOC to receive adequate mental health care including cultural and language differences, socioeconomic disparities, stigma, immigration status, and providers' cultural incompetency or bias.

It's important that individuals are directed to available resources to engage in healing, selfcare, community care, and proper coping with mental illness.
