#### Kidleidoscope

#### **Building the Canal Tour**

Come with us on a guided walk along the Blackstone Canal. Find out about the canal's historical and cultural significance and its role in the farm-to-factory transformation of the Blackstone Valley.

Appropriate for ages 12 and up. The walk is ~2 miles over a dirt-packed and forest surface with no inclines.

# Sundays 11 a.m. – 12 p.m.

#### **Woodlands and Waterways Tour**

Walk along the banks of the Blackstone River and learn about the life that it supports. We'll be looking for signs of wildlife as we discuss the ways we keep our watershed clean!

Appropriate for ages 12 and up. The walk is  $\sim 1$  mile over a dirt-packed and rugged forest surface with no inclines.
