



Segment 1 Phase 1











Blackstone River Greenway Section 1-7

Blackstone River Bikeway Rhode Island Section


20.6 miles from Providence to state line

- Phase 2: 0.5 miles (St. Paul Street to state line)











Scope of Work

- Rehabilitation of the Single Span and Seven Span Viaducts
 - Repairing structure
 - Installation of drainage system
- Improved Habitat with views of the Blackstone River











Typical Sections - Greenway

Typical Greenway Cross Sections






