September 5
2 – 3 p.m.**

Woodlands and Waterways
Walk along the banks of the Blackstone River and learn about the life that it supports. We’ll look for signs of wildlife as we discuss the ways we can keep our watershed clean! *Appropriate for ages 12 and up. The walk is ~1 mile over a paved surface with slight inclines. Meet at 205 North Main Street, Millbury, MA. Bathrooms and water are not available at this site.*

Bike the Blackstone
Come with us on a bike ride on the Blackstone River Greenway. Enjoy the scenery and look out for wildlife as we ride along the river. *Appropriate for ages 12 and up. The ride is ~6 miles on a paved surface with slight inclines and declines. Meet at 205 North Main Street, Millbury, MA. Riders under 16 must wear a helmet. Bathrooms and water are available at the midpoint.*

Mill to Meadow
The land on which the Visitor Center stands was once the largest factory complex in Worcester – and now not a single building remains! In this short walk (~1/4 mile) find out about “brownfield reclamation on site and how it fits into the Blackstone Valley’s environmental renaissance. *Appropriate for ages 12 and up.*
