After discussion, Dr. Reida was elected Vice Chair by a majority vote.

Dr. Dodes and Dr. DeVeue were nominated to be Secretary next year.

After discussion, Dr. Dodes was elected Secretary by a majority vote.

Dr. Storozuk then appointed Dr. DeVeue to review CEU applications and Dr. Imonti to continue to review monitoring reports.

Dr. Storozuk noted there were no more agenda items. A decision was made at 1:47 p.m. to adjourn the June 2, 2016 public meeting of the Board of Registration of Chiropractors.
