CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Mr. MacDonald at 1:31 p.m.

Item #1 MOTION- VOTE

Acceptance and Approval of October 7, 2020 Minutes

The motion was made by Ms. Jonas-Silver and seconded by Commissioner Suuberg and voted unanimously in favor of acceptance and approval of the minutes of the meeting of the Board held on October 7, 2020.

Item #2 REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Ms. Perez said that the Trust and MassDEP received the award letter for the Water Infrastructure Improvement for the Nation Act grant from EPA, which was applied for over the summer. The grant will fund the Expanded School Water Improvement Grant (ESWIG) program. It will allow ESWIG to offer grant proceeds to private schools and group childcare facilities in "Disadvantaged Communities" for the first time. ESWIG adds approximately \$3.75 million to the SWIG program. There was a press event this past Friday featuring Treasurer Goldberg and MassDEP to announce this grant award.

The school districts that have already been awarded SWIG grants were sent letters to inform them that they now have until April 9, 2021 to use their grant proceeds. Mr. Maple continues to communicate with these districts as they work to complete the grants.

Mr. Derouen said that a survey was sent to over 500 e-mail addresses for contacts in over 270 water utilities and municipalities that have not applied for State Revolving Fund (SRF) financing in 10 or more years. The Trust received 168 responses before the survey closed on October 30th. Thirty-seven respondents indicated in their responses that they would like to discuss SRF financing further with us. The Trust and MassDEP may hold a webinar for these thirty-seven communities where we can provide information and answer their questions.

Ms. Perez said that the working group for implementing the Water Infrastructure Transfer Act (WIFTA) will continue to discuss how the funds transferred from Clean Water to Drinking Water will be implemented. There may be Drinking Water projects on the 2021 Intended Use Plan (IUP) that are eligible to receive WIFTA funds. Hopefully there will be an update that can be provided during the December Board meeting.

The Project Evaluation Forms have been received and reviewed for the 2021 IUP and the Trust and MassDEP will continue the discussion regarding program capacity to determine how much SRF financing will be available for the 2021 IUP.
