**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order by Mr. MacDonald at 1:35 p.m.

## Item #1 MOTION- VOTE

## Acceptance and Approval of February 9, 2021 Minutes

The motion was made by Ms. Jonas-Silver and seconded by Commissioner Suuberg and voted unanimously in favor of acceptance and approval of the minutes of the meeting of the Board held on February 9, 2021.

## Item #2 **REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE**

## **EPA Annual Review**

Ms. Perez said that after the EPA's annual review, there were a couple of issues noted in their report.

Similar to last year, the Clean Water Trust was cited for not requiring borrowers listed on the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA) reports to also submit a single audit and show Trust loan disbursements on their Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards (SEFA). The Trust disagrees with this interpretation because projects reported in FFATA do not necessarily receive federal funds and if the borrower does not receive federal funds, there would not being any funding to report on the SEFA. The Trust has discussed this with its outside auditors who agree with the Trust's interpretation. The Trust will continue to work with EPA towards a solution.

The other issue noted was how MassDEP requests advances of set-aside funding ahead of each quarter from the Trust instead of in advance of each biweekly pay period. This has been standard practice since the inception of the program. Receiving a quarter's worth of funds ahead of time ensures that there are sufficient funds for payroll and other administrative expenses. However, this year the EPA cited this as an issue because advance requests should not be made more than a pay period ahead of time. The Trust will work with DEP and propose a solution to EPA.

## Meeting with Senator Markey's Office

Ms. Perez said that Mr. Keenan and herself will meet with staff members from Senator Markey's office at 4 PM. The Senator's office requested the meeting to discuss water issues in Massachusetts.

Ms. Perez said that after notice for this meeting was posted, revised agreements for two loans for the City of Lawrence, CWP-19-06 and CWP-19-06-A, were sent to the Trust. Lawrence expects to need more loan proceeds for construction costs than originally expected and less loan proceeds for architecture and engineering than originally expected. Approving these revisions will result in costs being moved from one loan to another, not an overall increase in the cost of the project.
