The annual federal Clean Water and Drinking Water grants have been received.

There are now 29 school districts that have been disbursed a total of \$648,000 in proceeds for the School Water Improvement Grant (SWIG) program. The Trust will provide more information on filtered water bottle filling stations being installed as it becomes available.
