• **Proposal Number 5-9-2018** – Review and take final vote on action taken via emergency measures during the June 5th meeting to revise Section 2603.5.5 to coordinate with final amendments made to Sections 1403.5 and 1407.10.4 of the ninth edition code by eliminating exception number 2.

2603.5.5 Revise subsection as follows:

2603.5.5 Vertical and Lateral Fire Propagation.

The exterior wall assembly shall be tested in accordance with and comply with theacceptancecriteria of NFPA 285.

EXCEPTIONS:

- Wall assemblies where the foam plastic insulation is covered on each face by not less than one-inch (25 mm) thickness of masonry, concrete, terracotta, stucco or ½-inch-thick Type X gypsum board and meeting one of the following:
 - 2.1 There is no airspace between the insulation and the masonry, concrete, terracotta, stucco, or ½-inch thick type X gypsum board.
 - 2.2 The insulation has a flame spread index of not more than 25 as determined in accordance with ASTM E 84 or UL 723 and the maximum airspace between the insulation and the concrete or masonry is not more than 1 inch (25 mm).
- 2. In other than high rise buildings, walls in buildings equipped throughout with an automatic sprinkler system, with the following conditions: 1) only where a NFPA 13 sprinkler system is provided and 2) where fire flow analysis has been performed without sprinkler decrease allowance that shows adequate water is available.
