NEW BUSINESS:

• Dr. David Boyden

Dr. Boyden presented to the Board to discuss the process and requirements toward regaining a chiropractic license in Massachusetts. The Board gave direction to Dr. Boyden that he would need to submit an application for licensure and demonstrate that he met all current requirements. The Board advised Dr. Boyden that determining whether to reinstate a revoked chiropractic license is a discretionary decision of the Board based on the public interest, and that the Board could impose probationary conditions on any such reinstatement.

Thereafter, the Board will respond explaining that Massachusetts chiropractic regulations does not mandate that chiropractors performing peer reviews report to the Board evidence of regulatory violations by another chiropractor, unless the suspected violation is egregious that it presents a threat to public safety. However, any chiropractor may choose to report suspected regulatory violations to the Board.
