License exam results appeal of Stephen Smith Chairman Dan Kilburn introduced himself and members of the Board. Chairman Kilburn stated that he read Mr. Smith's appeal and reviewed the exam. Chairman Kilburn asked Mr. Smith where he worked, and Mr. Smith stated he worked for the Town of Avon. Chairman Kilburn asked how many 1B licensed persons worked for the Town and Mr. Smith stated that there was one, but he left. Chairman Kilburn stated it was clear from Mr. Smith's exam that he was guessing on the answers and recommended that he take a 1B course. Mr. Smith stated he only had the 1C material for review before the exam. Chairman Kilburn asked Mr. Smith if he had any questions for the Board and he indicated he did not. After the public hearing concluded, the Board deliberated in quasi-judicial session and unanimously denied the appeal.
