License exam results appeal of Paul M. Christopher Chairman Dan Kilburn introduced himself and members of the Board. Chairman Kilburn stated that he read Mr. Christopher's appeal and reviewed the exam. Chairman Kilburn stated the appeal alleged that there were repeated questions. Chairman Kilburn stated he did review the questions and there were two questions that were similar but not repeated. Also it was noted that Mr. Christopher missed passing by quite a bit. Chairman Kilburn asked Mr. Christopher if he attended a training course and Mr. Christopher said he did but it was about two years ago. Chairman Kilburn asked if he had anything else to add to his appeal. Mr. Christopher indicated he did not. Chairman Kilburn informed Mr. Christopher that the board would take the information under advisement and he would receive a decision in the mail. After the public hearing concluded, the Board deliberated in quasijudicial session and unanimously denied the appeal.

License exam results appeal of Alexandre Medeiros Chairman Dan Kilburn introduced himself and members of the Board. Chairman Kilburn stated that he read Mr. Medeiros appeal and reviewed the exam. Mr. Medeiros stated that he recognized some discrepancies with the exam and the study materials. Chairman Kilburn asked Mr. Medeiros to provide some examples and he did. Chairman Kilburn stated he went through all the questions and they were correct. Chairman Kilburn asked if he had any other questions he wanted verified and Mr. Medeiros stated he did not and that he appreciated the opportunity to discuss the questions with the Board. Chairman Kilburn informed Mr. Medeiros that the board would take the information under advisement and he would receive a decision in the mail. After the public hearing concluded, the Board deliberated in quasi-judicial session and denied the appeal.
