❖ D3 – Central Massachusetts Technical School / Cape Cod Plumbing School Online - Online Plumbing Tier Education Program

Applicant Michael O'Connor is seeking Board Approval of a new online Plumbing Tier Education Program consisting of Tiers 1 thru 5

VARIANCE REQUESTS

❖ PV-91 - Mass College of Liberal Arts-375 Church St-North Adams-Attend

Applicant John Ineson of EDM Services, Inc. are requesting a variance from 248 CMR 10.10 (18) (r) Use of Gender-neutral Toilet Rooms. They are requesting a bathroom containing multiple fixtures including two urinals, one water closet and two lavatories allow to be designated as gender neutral. Since this is a state facility, no board of health was notified.

❖ PV-92 - Durfee High School-360 Elsbree Street-Fall River

Applicant Ronald Furbish of Griffith and Vary, Inc. is seeking a variance from 248 CMR 10.17 Storm Drains (5) Sub-soil Drains, (c) Area Drains. The plumbing contractor nor Griffith and Vary are able to find an 18" Ductile back water valve. They are requesting the use of a PVC backwater valve. The backwater valve will be installed within 10 feet from the inner foundation of the building. The Fall Rive Board of Health had been properly petitioned.

❖ PV - 93 - Durfee High School-360 Elsbree Street-Fall River

Applicant Ronald Furbish of Griffith and Vary, Inc. is seeking a variance from 248 CMR. They are requesting the use of PVC schedule 40 piping to collect all the pool deck drains. The Fall Rive Board of Health had been properly petitioned.

❖ PV-95 - Brad Otis - 1 Woodside Ave - Winchester

This is a Post Installation Plumbing Variance. Applicant and installing plumber Bill Spolidoro is seeking relief from 248 CMR 3.04 (1) Product Acceptance. The cast iron tub installed is not compliant with the non-skid surface standard. The Town of Winchester Board of Health has been properly petitioned.

❖ GV-100-Massachusetts Institute of Technology-50-60 Albany St.-Cambridge

Applicant John Shaughnessy is seeking a variance from State Fuel Gas Code and 248 CMR 3.04 (1). The request is the approval of (2) – 6" Cameron NewCo Swing check valves (300 GS) Stainless and (4) 6" Cameron NewCo Swing check valves (300 G) Carbon. Since this is a gas variance, Board of Health notification is not required.

❖ PV-96 - Lillian Monalto Signature Properties-34 Park St.-Andover

Applicant George L Elston III of Jay Elston Plumbing and Heating is seeking a variance from 248 CMR 10.10 Table 1. They have installed filtered drinking water faucets in the staff kitchen on floors 1 and 2 and at the wet bar on the third floor conference room of the 3 story building and are asking the Board to eliminate the required drinking fountains. The Andover Board of Health has been petitioned.

❖ PV-101-Wentworth Institute-550 Huntington Ave-Boston

Walter B. Adams of WBA Associates are seeking a variance from 248 CMR 10.10 (18) (R) on behalf of Wentworth Institute of Technology Willson Hall toilet room renovation. They are requesting to change a men room with 8 toilet/urinal fixtures into a gender neutral room with 5 toilet fixtures. One toilet compartment will be compliant with 521 CMR. All the toilet stall partitions will be constructed with metal studs, gypsum wall board and tile cladding, from the floor to a height of 7-8 feet above the floor to allow individual privacy. Boston Inspectional Services has been properly petitioned.

❖ PV-102-Dragon Paradise, LLC.-270 Main St., Agawam

Applicant Robert Hoyle of Chem-X is seeking a variance from 248 CMR 10.15 (10) (a) They are requesting an alternate method to gravity drainage system. The Agawam Board of Health has been petitioned.

❖ PV-104-DCR-180 Old Kings Highway-Wellfleet

Applicant Kevin McHugh of Coneco Engineers & Scientists, Inc. are seeking a variance from 248 CMR. They are requesting the installation of an outdoor standard along with a 521 CMR compliant shower and dishwashing station. The applicant states the fixtures will be covered by a permanent roof and the showers will be enclosed by walls. This is a state facility therefore Board of Health was not petitioned.

❖ PV-106-Essex County Sheriff's Dept-20 Manning Ave.-Middleton

Applicant Sean Gallager is seeking a variance from 248 CMR 10.10 (18) Table 1 Minimum facilities. The applicant states that after a renovation of the facility they will be short 2 toilets and 2 showers with no room to expand. This is a state facility therefore Board of Health was not petitioned.

❖ PV-110-University of Massachusetts Dartmouth-285 Old Westport Rd-North Dartmouth

Applicant Patrick Harold of Harold Brothers is seeking a variance from 248 CMR 10.10 (18) (g) 5. They are requesting P3 Residence Hall utilize gender neutral toilet and shower rooms. The location of these bathrooms include all floors of the north and south Residence Halls. Each toilet room core will include single user toilet and shower rooms with full height partitions. The lavatories will be open and shared amongst the occupants. This is a state facility therefore Board of Health was not petitioned.

❖ PV-109 – University of Massachusetts-360 Campus Center Way-Amherst

This is a Post Installation Variance. Installing Plumbing Contractor Thomas Conway of TJ Conway Company is seeking a variance from 248 CMR 10.12 (1) (see **PV -105**). They are requesting the Board allow the drainage of a 6000 gallon wave tank enter the building sanitary drainage system. The applicant states that the Superintendent of Public Works has been petitioned regarding this variance. This is a state facility therefore Board of Health was not petitioned.

❖ PV-105-UMass-360 Campus Center Way-Amherst

Applicant Finn Chappell of Architectural Engineers Inc. are seeking a variance from 248 CMR 10.12 (1). They are requesting the Board allow the drainage of a 6000 gallon wave tank enter the building sanitary drainage system. The applicant states that the Superintendent of Public Works has been petitioned regarding this variance. This is a state facility therefore Board of Health was not petitioned.

❖ PV-111 - UMass - Boyden Gym and Mullins Center – Amherst

This is a Post Installation Variance. Installing Plumbing Contractor Thomas Conway of TJ Conway Company is seeking a variance from 248 CMR 10.15 (1), 10.02 (26) and 10.03. The request is to connect the pool to potable water and to allow the drain to be connected indirectly. They are also requesting the Board allow the use of a non-product accepted special fixture (Hydrotherapy Pool). This is a state facility therefore Board of Health was not petitioned.

❖ PV-41 - MBTA Green Line Extension Lechmere Station - Cambridge

This is one of six variance requests submitted by Terrence McCarthy on behalf of the MBTA. The North head house has employee toilets (male and female). The MBTA are requesting to not provide public toilet facilities. This is a state facility therefore no Board of Health has been notified.

❖ PV-45 - MBTA Green Line Extension Lechmere and College Avenue Stations - Medford

This is the fifth of six variance requests submitted by Terrence McCarthy on behalf of the MBTA. This request is for no public bathrooms and employee toilets that are located more than 300 feet from the starter booth. This is a state facility therefore no Board of Health has been notified.

❖ PV-46 - MBTA Union Square Station - Somerville

This is the sixth of six variance requests submitted by Terrence McCarthy on behalf of the MBTA. This request is for no public bathrooms and employee toilets that are located more than 300 feet from the starter booth as well as off site of the station as negotiated by the MBTA and the adjacent real estate developer.. This is a state facility therefore no Board of Health has been notified.

They have included a note from a health care professional. The in-office approval included the condition of a six inch threshold from the top of the drain outlet to the top of the barrier lip and only one two point five gallon per minute maximum shower head.

Applicant Gerald Venezia has requested the continued use of an inch and a half drain for a tub to shower conversion. The Cambridge Board of Health has been properly notified. APPEAL OF AN INSPECTORS DECISION

❖ AID - 112 - Owen, Paul - Bathfitter - 135 Muttton Lane – Weymouth Applicant Paul Owen is appealing the decision of the Local Plumbing Inspector for the Town of Weymouth regarding the minimum temperature of hot water. Mr. Owen states Inspector Stetson failed to notify the homeowner of a violation of plumbing code. Inspector Stetson documented a hot water temperature of 118 degrees Fahrenheit on July 19, 2019. Mr. Owen states the minimum hot water temperature fell outside the scope of the work outlined on the permit (shower valve installation). The application for appeal has been submitted within 10 days, according to M.G.L. c.142 s. 13.
