BOARD OF REVIEW DECISION

<u>Introduction and Procedural History of this Appeal</u>

The claimant appeals a decision by a review examiner of the Department of Unemployment Assistance (DUA) determining that the claimant was overpaid benefits due to a misrepresentation of facts under G.L. c. 151A, § 69(a). We review, pursuant to our authority under G.L. c. 151A, § 41, and affirm.

On October 1, 2015, the DUA sent the claimant a Notice of Disqualification and a Notice of Fault Finding, informing her that she had an overpayment of benefits, because she gave information to the DUA that she knew or reasonably should have known was false. The claimant filed a timely appeal and attended a hearing on November 5, 2015. In a decision issued on August 2, 2018, ¹ the review examiner affirmed the overpayment and the fault/fraud finding. The claimant filed a timely application for review with the Board on August 3, 2018, and it was accepted for review.

Ruling of the Board

After considering the recorded testimony and evidence from the hearing, the review examiner's decision, and the claimant's appeal, we conclude that the review examiner's decision is based on substantial evidence and is free from any error of law affecting substantive rights. Therefore, the review examiner's decision is affirmed.
