## **BOARD OF REVIEW DECISION**

## Introduction and Procedural History of this Appeal

The claimant appeals a decision by a review examiner of the Department of Unemployment Assistance (DUA) to deny the claimant unemployment benefits following his separation from employment on April 7, 2019. We review, pursuant to our authority under G.L. c. 151A, § 41, and affirm.

On April 24, 2019, the agency initially determined that the claimant was not entitled to unemployment benefits. The claimant appealed and attended the hearing. In a decision rendered on June 14, 2019, the review examiner affirmed the agency determination, concluding that the claimant was not actively searching for work that he was physically capable of doing, given his medical condition. Thus, the claimant was disqualified under G.L. c. 151A, § 24(b). The Board accepted the claimant's application for review.

## Ruling of the Board

After considering the recorded testimony and evidence from the hearing, the review examiner's decision, and the claimant's appeal, we conclude that the review examiner's decision to disqualify the claimant pursuant to G.L. c. 151A, § 24(b), is based on substantial evidence and is free from any error of law affecting substantive rights. The evidence supports disqualification, beginning April 7, 2019.

The review examiner's decision is, therefore, affirmed. The claimant is denied benefits for the period beginning April 7, 2019, and for subsequent weeks, until such time as he is actively searching for jobs which he is physically capable of doing.

If the claimant does start looking for work that he is physically capable of performing, a completed work search log should be presented to the DUA. He may contact the DUA Customer Service Unit for assistance at (617) 626-5400.
