BOARD OF REVIEW DECISION

Introduction and Procedural History of this Appeal

The claimant appeals a decision by a review examiner of the Department of Unemployment Assistance (DUA) to deny the claimant benefits following his separation from employment on August 11, 2019. We review, pursuant to our authority under G.L. c. 151A, § 41, and affirm.

On October 9, 2019, the agency initially determined that the claimant was not entitled to unemployment benefits. The claimant appealed and attended the hearing. In a decision rendered on November 15, 2019, the review examiner affirmed the agency determination, concluding that the claimant was not able, available, and actively searching for work and, thus, was disqualified under G.L. c. 151A, § 24(b), during the period starting August 11, 2019, and indefinitely thereafter. The Board accepts the claimant's application for review.

Ruling of the Board

After considering the recorded testimony and evidence from the hearing, the review examiner's decision, and the claimant's appeal, we conclude that the review examiner's decision to disqualify the claimant pursuant to G.L. c. 151A, § 24(b), is based on substantial evidence and is free from any error of law affecting substantive rights. The evidence supports disqualification through the date of the hearing decision, the week beginning November 10, 2019.

The review examiner's decision is, therefore, affirmed. The claimant is denied benefits for the period from August 11, 2019, to November 16, 2019.

The Board notes that the claimant has asserted on appeal that he is now available for work because he has begun receiving assistance with family care, which may affect his eligibility beginning the week of November 17, 2019. Based upon this new information, the DUA will be asked to investigate and issue a new determination as to whether the claimant meets the requirements of G.L. c. 151A, § 24(b), beginning November 17, 2019.
