## Introduction and Procedural History of this Appeal

The claimant appeals a decision by a review examiner of the Department of Unemployment Assistance (DUA) to deny the claimant a hearing following her late appeal of a determination issued by the DUA. We review, pursuant to our authority under G.L. c. 151A, § 41, and affirm.

On July 22, 2019, the agency initially determined that the claimant was not entitled to unemployment benefits under G.L. c. 151A, § 24(b). The claimant appealed the determination on January 3, 2020, 165 days after the determination was issued. On January 31, 2020, the agency determined that the claimant did not have a good cause for failing to file her appeal within the tenday appeal period. The claimant appealed the second determination and attended the hearing. In a decision rendered on February 29, 2020, the review examiner affirmed the agency determination, concluding that the claimant did not have good cause for failing to appeal timely, and, thus, she was not entitled to a hearing under G.L. c. 151A § 39(b). The Board accepts the claimant's application for review.

## Ruling of the Board

After considering the recorded testimony and evidence from the hearing, the review examiner's decision, and the claimant's appeal, we conclude that the review examiner's decision is based on substantial evidence and is free from any error of law affecting substantive rights.

The review examiner's decision is, therefore, affirmed. The claimant's appeal of the underlying G.L. c. 151A, § 24(b), determination shall be dismissed.

However, the Board notes that the claimant has presented new medical documentation, which may affect her eligibility during the period beginning December 15, 2019. Based upon this new information, the DUA will be asked to investigate and issue a new determination as to whether the claimant met the requirements of G.L. c. 151A, § 24(b), for the period beginning December 15, 2019.
