Introduction and Procedural History of this Appeal

The claimant appeals a decision by a review examiner of the Department of Unemployment Assistance (DUA) to deny the claimant benefits. We review, pursuant to our authority under G.L. c. 151A, § 41, and affirm.

On July 2, 2020, the agency initially determined that the claimant was not entitled to unemployment benefits. The claimant appealed and attended the hearing. In a decision rendered on December 30, 2020, the review examiner affirmed the agency determination, concluding that the claimant was not able, available, and actively searching for work from the week beginning April 5, 2020, through August 29, 2020, and, thus, was disqualified under G.L. c. 151A, § 24(b). The Board accepted the claimant's application for review.

Ruling of the Board

After considering the recorded testimony and evidence from the hearing, the review examiner's decision, and the claimant's appeal, we conclude that the review examiner's decision to disqualify the claimant pursuant to G.L. c. 151A, § 24(b), is based on substantial evidence and is free from any error of law affecting substantive rights. The evidence supports disqualification from the week beginning April 5, 2020 through August 29, 2020.

The review examiner's decision is affirmed. The claimant is denied benefits for the week beginning April 5, 2020 through August 29, 2020. He is entitled to receive benefits for the week beginning August 30, 2020, and for subsequent weeks thereafter if otherwise eligible.
