Introduction and Procedural History of this Appeal

The claimant appeals a decision by a review examiner of the Department of Unemployment Assistance (DUA) to deny the claimant training benefits. We review, pursuant to our authority under G.L. c. 151A, § 41, and affirm.

On July 3, 2021, the agency initially determined that the claimant was not entitled to training benefits from May 17, 2021, through August 6, 2021. The claimant appealed and attended the hearing. In a decision rendered on August 17, 2021, the review examiner affirmed the denial of training benefits, concluding that the claimant was not enrolled on a full-time basis and, thus, was disqualified under G.L. c. 151A, § 30(c). The Board accepted the claimant's application for review.

Ruling of the Board

After considering the recorded testimony and evidence from the hearing, the review examiner's decision, and the claimant's appeal, we conclude that the review examiner's decision is based on substantial evidence and is free from any error of law affecting substantive rights.

The review examiner's decision is affirmed. The claimant is not entitled to training benefits between May 17, 2021, and August 6, 2021.

N.B.: While the claimant failed here to establish that she attended her training program on a full-time basis during the Summer of 2021, we note that the claimant and her training provider uploaded to UI Online various documents (including a Training Opportunities Program Application signed by the provider on June 24, 2021, and various transcripts) between June 25 and June 29, 2021.

Because these documents pertain to the upcoming Fall 2021 semester, beginning on or about September 9, 2021, we ask that the claimant's eligibility for training benefits as of that date be investigated and adjudicated accordingly.
