Introduction and Procedural History of this Appeal

The claimant appeals a decision by a review examiner of the Department of Unemployment Assistance (DUA) to deny the claimant benefits as a result of her separation from employment on September 8, 2022. We review, pursuant to our authority under G.L. c. 151A, § 41, and affirm.

On October 4, 2022, the agency initially determined that the claimant was not entitled to unemployment benefits. The claimant appealed, and both parties attended the hearing. In a decision rendered on January 28, 2023, the review examiner affirmed the agency determination, concluding that the claimant voluntarily left employment without showing good cause attributable to the employer or urgent, compelling, and necessitous reasons, and, thus, she was disqualified under G.L. c. 151A, § 25(e)(1), effective January 8, 2022. The Board accepted the claimant's application for review.

Ruling of the Board

After considering the recorded testimony and evidence from the hearing, the review examiner's decision, and the claimant's appeal, we conclude that the review examiner's decision to disqualify the claimant under G.L. c. 151A, § 25(e)(1), is based on substantial evidence and is free from any error of law affecting substantive rights.

However, we revise the disqualification date. The January 8, 2022, disqualification date noted in the hearing decision appears to be an error, as the claimant continued working for the employer beyond January 8, 2022.

The review examiner's decision is affirmed. The claimant is denied benefits for the week beginning September 11, 2022, and for subsequent weeks, until such time as she has had at least eight weeks of work and has earned an amount equivalent to or in excess of eight times her weekly benefit amount.
