## **BOARD OF REVIEW DECISION**

## Introduction and Procedural History of this Appeal

The claimant appeals a decision by a review examiner of the Department of Unemployment Assistance (DUA) to authorize the Department of Revenue (DOR) to intercept the claimant's state tax refund to repay an overpayment of unemployment benefits. We review, pursuant to our authority under G.L. c. 151A, § 41, and affirm.

On February 12, 2018, the DOR sent the claimant a Notice of Refund Applied to Debt or Transferred, which showed that the claimant's entire personal income tax refund of \$2,129.00 was being applied to his outstanding overpayment balance with the DUA. The claimant appealed and attended the hearing. In a decision rendered on April 19, 2018, the review examiner affirmed the agency determination, concluding that pursuant to G.L. c. 151A, § 69B, the tax intercept was correct. The Board accepted the claimant's application for review.

## Ruling of the Board

After considering the recorded testimony and evidence from the hearing, the review examiner's decision, and the claimant's appeal, we conclude that the review examiner's decision is based on substantial evidence and is free from any error of law affecting substantive rights.

The review examiner's decision is affirmed.
