- Report from eLicensing
 - Number of licenses still not linked?
 - > 03/25/2019 There were 11,342 EL licenses with linked public user accounts.
 - > 04/16/2019 There are currently 13,211 linked licenses
 - 1282 have already renewed since April 8th
 - (There are ~38K licensees up for renewal this cycle)
 - New licenses will be received 4 to 6 weeks after renewed on line.
- Prior to May 1st, 2019, Candidates who successfully pass the Journeyman or Master Electrician licensing exam will receive a license with an expiration date of 07/31/2019. They will have to complete a 15hr code update course to renew and pay the renewal fee. Licenses with a 07/31/2022 will be issued starting May 1st. 2019.

• The DPL has installed four computer kiosks in the 7th lobby. License holders who need help linking their licenses or renewing can come to the DPL for one to one assistance.

A Hot Work Safety Certificate for all persons engaged in hot work operations on the work Site becomes mandatory state-wide in Massachusetts starting July 1, 2018.

What is Hot Work? (527 CMR Chapter 41)

Hot work is any activity or process that involves open flames or that generates sparks or heat and includes: Welding and allied processes; heat treating; grinding; thawing pipes; powder-driven fasteners; hot riveting; torch-applied roofing; and any similar applications producing or using sparks, flame or heat.
