The minutes from the BOCC meeting on **December 5, 2019**, were reviewed by members present; MOTION to approve these minutes, as amended, was made by **Robert Speroni**, and seconded by **Michael Clancy**.

3. Application for Certification Packets

- a. On a MOTION by Michael Clancy and seconded by John Naff it was unanimously VOTED to approve the application of **Hamror Gabriel** (City of Springfield) for certification in the capacity of **Local Inspector** having met the minimum qualifications for said position defined by MGL c 143 § 3. (BO-2161).
- b. On a MOTION by David Lenzie and seconded by Roger Fuller it was unanimously VOTED to approve the application of **Steven Latulippe** (City of Beverly) for certification in the capacity of **Local Inspector** having met the minimum qualifications for said position defined by MGL c 143 § 3. (BO-2156).

- f. On a MOTION by Andy Bobola and seconded by David Lenzie it was unanimously VOTED to **DENY** the request of **Tam Nguyen** (No Affiliation) for approval to take the required exams to become certified as a building code enforcement official. According to Mr. Nguyen's resume and the additional information submitted the Committee was unable to determine if they have the minimum qualifications as defined by MGL c 143 § 3.
- g. On a MOTION by David Lenzie and seconded by John Naff it was unanimously VOTED to grant the request of **Matthew Rossi** (No Affiliation) for approval to take the required exams to become certified as a building code enforcement official. After reviewing an updated resume the Committee determined Mr. Rossi meets the minimum qualifications set forth by the BBRS for said position of local inspector and inspector of buildings / building commissioner defined by MGL c 143 § 3 and was granted permission to proceed with the required examination process.

- b. Review *Examination Approval Form*: Discussion was had and in agreement to reflect an individual's experience for *Education Use* copies of any degree is required to be included with resume. If an individual is using the *Combination of education and work experience* a copy of the education transcript completed, so far, required. The Examination Approval From will be updated and review changes February 4, 2020.
- c. Definitions for 'degree in building construction' and FAQ's. The Committee reviewed a list of FAQ's, which includes the general definition of a degree provide by Charles Kilb and made a few changes. The FAQ's will be reviewed again February 4, 2020. The FAQ's will be posted on the website.
- d. On a Motion by Bonnie Weeks and seconded by John Naff, finding the new submissions, submitted by Craig Edsall, do not comply with the original decision, it was unanimously voted to uphold the original decision on May 9, 2018 and June 6, 2018 that he does not meet the minimum qualifications as defined by MGL c 143 § 3.
