## 1) Review/Vote- Meeting Minutes for March 4, 2025

## 2) Review/Discuss Executive Director Report

She reported there is a lag time to post as there are steps prior to entering into system - training occurs, sheet must be sent to BOCC, list approved at monthly meeting, finally hours are input.

## 3) Review/Discuss Board Counsel Report

Philip Chan reported that the governor recently moved to extend the COVID era remote and hybrid meeting allowances for public meetings until June 30, 2027.

## 4) Discuss/Vote BOCC Hearing Process and Subcommittee

Tammy Gropman asked the BOCC members to volunteer for a subcommittee of 5 to conduct hearings for the individuals who have expired building licenses and still working to fulfill the 45 hours of CEU credits for the past cycle. Michael Giampietro, John Naff, Kevin Ross, Mark Robidoux and Henry Fontaine volunteered.

John Naff made a motion to accept the five volunteers for the BOCC hearing process subcommittee, seconded by Kevin Ross. A roll call vote was conducted, the motion passed unanimously.

Board Counsel Chan proposed to BOCC they could negotiate consent agreements with a combination of civil penalty and additional CEUs. Board counsel will draft, and review will be completed by subcommittee of 5. There are approximately 14 individuals who would be summoned.

## 5) Review/Discuss Extension of Time Policy

Vice Chair Naff highlighted that for a conditional appointee, the clock starts for testing on the original date of appointment noted on the NERF, not when the NERF comes in and is processed. There is much confusion about this. There was further discussion about what causes the confusion, including the NERF not being sent in by a municipality, who's responsibility is it to send in, and no understanding of the dates of importance. Andy Bobola asked if a letter could be sent by staff and staff agreed to explore. Chair Giampietro asked if Director of Building Training Ross Seavey could also do some outreach. Ross Seavey mentioned this has already been developed and is currently being reviewed by legal. It was noted the BOCC can change the extension of time policy but not R7. This could be added as an agenda item in the future to make changes to the policy.

## 6) Review/Vote changes to BOCC Approved Courses for PSD

Tammy Gropman reported that PSD reached out to us they had updated some of the content of several of the BOCC approved courses to reflect recent changes to the MA stretch code.

John Naff made a motion to approve the three separate slides for Commercial, Residential Stretch and residential existing building for PSD, seconded by David Fuller. A roll call vote was conducted, the motion passed unanimously.

## 7) Hearings

#### a. Newman, Erik C25-00006

Erik Newman was present at today's meeting. The BOCC issued a complaint against Mr. Newman. Based on documents provided, Mr. Newman's Conditional Building Inspector Certification expired on November 14, 2023. Mr. Newman continued to hold this position as Conditional Building Inspector until January 7, 2025. His application for certification was approved by the BOCC on January 14, 2025. Mr. Newman was notified of this complaint via letter requesting written response to the allegations stated in the complaint. Mr. Newman provided a written response to the complaint stating he received a conditional license with an expiration date of December 31, 2024. He stated if he knew he had to get it done sooner, he would have. Mr. Newman explained he did receive his certification and was up to date on his CEUs. Board Counsel Kilb asked some clarifying questions to which Mr. Newman answered his understanding was that his conditional

license did expire December 31, 2024, he had completed his testing prior to that date but did not have a chance to bring it to the BOCC for approval, and he did act as a building official for the Town of Ipswich with an expired license during January 1, 2025 and the time he received a notice from the BOCC. The board asked other clarifying questions about Mr. Newman's appointment date, the number of tests taken, dates on the extension requests and how many extensions were granted. Mr. Newman stated he was not receiving emails for a certain period. David Fuller made a motion to close the public hearing, seconded by John Naff. The motion was approved unanimously.

## b. Anderson, David BOCC 2-2025

David Anderson was present at today's hearing, represented by his Counsel Joseph Noone. He requested a hearing to appeal the denial of his extension of time request from the regularly scheduled February 2025 meeting. Counsel Noone stated there was some confusion with R7 and the timeframes. Mr. Anderson submitted numerous emails and correspondence requesting information about the timelines. Mr. Anderson stated that was not attempting to avoid his obligations to take the tests but due to a lack of clarity from his and his commissioner's standpoint, he missed the deadline. Letters were submitted on Mr. Andersons behalf. Mr. Anderson asserted that was no ill intent not to comply with time regulations but a simple misunderstanding. The board asked clarifying questions to understand the timeline of when he was hired and approved to take the tests. Mr. Anderson stated he did not hear from the board for a period of 5 months and mentioned the difficulty of the exams. Board Counsel Chan reviewed 110 R7.1.7 sections. Vice chair Naff asked questions about why he did not submit for extension earlier. Mr. Rogers stated there was also an issue with the NERF not being sent in 2023 but in 2025. Mr. Noone presented final statements to the board addressing confusion with regulations and when exams must be taken, and NERF being submitted. He is asking for a 6-month extension to comply with requirements and respectfully asks the board to grant this extension. Mr. Anderson was diligent in trying to get the approvals and information needed. David Fuller made a motion to close the public hearing, seconded by John Naff. The motion was approved unanimously.

#### c. Bloom, Christopher BOCC 4-2025

Christopher Bloom was present at today's hearing accompanied by Tom Quinlan, Building Commissioner for Hadley. He requested a hearing to appeal the denial of his examination approval application at the March 2025 meeting. His examination approval application was previously rejected based upon a lack of five years of supervisory construction experience. Mr. Bloom provided copies of his resume and spoke about his experience project managing, construction supervision as a CSL, and pulling building permits. Mr. Long spoke on Mr. Bloom's behalf. David Fuller and Vice Chair Naff recognized that the resume provided on last application was more detailed on the real estate side and did not provide information to make a quality decision on his candidacy. Andrew Bobola made a motion to close the public hearing, seconded by Michael Clancy. The motion was approved unanimously.

## d. LoCoco, Joseph BOCC 1-2025

Joseph LoCoco was present at today's hearing. He requested a hearing to appeal the denial of his extension of time request from the regularly scheduled February 2025 meeting. His extension of time request was denied due to an appointment date of October 16, 2023. There were no prior extension requests. Mr. Lococo stated it was a misunderstanding and believed he had a year to file for an extension. Mr. Lococo stated he completed the onboarding training. The board asked clarifying questions about dates. Mr. Lococo presented final statements and said if he knew the time allotted, he would have completed the testing. John Naff made a motion to close the public hearing, seconded by George Peterson. The motion was approved unanimously.

#### e. Muscatiello, Paul BOCC 3-2025

Paul Muscatiello was present at today's meeting accompanied by Jack Mee, Building Commissioner for Harwich. He requested a hearing to appeal the denial of his extension of time request from the regularly scheduled March 2025 meeting. His extension of time request was denied due to a late submission of the request. Mr. Muscatiello stated he had some confusion and received some misinformation about when to apply for an extension of time. He had taken the ICC residential exam and failed it in the first six months. He took the Onboarding Session. Since failing, he has passed the residential test through the NCPCCI. He is asking the board to reconsider their decision. Mr. Mee spoke on Paul's behalf and on his qualifications and respectfully requests a 6-month extension. George Peterson asked Mr. Muscatiello if there is one thing that the board could do to make it clearer to new inspectors on how to follow the process without having these types of issues come up. Mr. Muscatiello recommended making the dates very clear. David Fuller made a motion to close the public hearing, seconded by John Naff. The motion was approved unanimously.
