Bolton Country Cupboard, Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 22, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Temple's Report.

<u>FACTS</u>

- 1. On Monday, May 20, 2013, at approximately 6:03 p.m., Investigators Doyle and Temple conducted an investigation of the business operation of Bolton Country Cupboard, Inc.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a sixteen ounce (16 oz.) container of Budweiser Light beer for one dollar and eighty-five cents (\$1.85). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
