Dr. Bush informed those individuals in attendance that the Board meeting is being conducted via teleconference. Additionally, the Board meeting is being recorded by a stenographer. Under Open Meeting Law, specifically Mass. General Laws chapter 30A, section 20(f), any person who makes a video or audio recording must first notify the chair, so that the chair may notify other attendees of any recordings. Dr. Bush asked if anyone present was making a recording. No one spoke.

Mietto, Cristina

The Board considered the Request for a waiver of one year of accredited postgraduate training and the Full License application.

Dr. Mietto was present via teleconference.

Roisin Cahill, Deputy Director of Licensing, was present via teleconference.

Ms. Cahill informed the Board that Dr. Mietto had only completed one year of ACGME-accredited clinical postgraduate training in the Critical Care Anesthesia Fellowship at MGH. Accordingly, Dr. Mietto is requesting that the Board waive the requirement to complete a second year of accredited training and that the Board accept her clinical teaching experience as a substitute. Additionally, Ms. Cahill informed the Board that Dr. Mietto had held a clinical faculty appointment as an Instructor of Anesthesia at Harvard Medical School (“HMS”) for nearly two years, January 2024 through the present. HMS is an LCME accredited medical school. In conjunction with her faculty appointment at HMS, Dr. Mietto has been an attending anesthesiologist at MGH practicing under a temporary faculty license.

In the **Mietto** matter, Mr. O’Donnell moved to allow the Request for a waiver of one year of accredited postgraduate training and, as a substitute, acceptance of her clinical teaching experience. In so doing, the Board will discuss the reputation, character, physical condition or mental health, rather than professional competence, of a licensee, or the discipline or dismissal of, or complaints or charges against a licensee, as permitted under purpose 1 and information that may not be publicly disclosed pursuant to Mass. General Laws, chapter 112, section 5 and Mass. General Laws, chapter 66A, section 2, as permitted under purpose 7. The Board will also be reviewing Executive Session Minutes.

Following the Executive Session, the Board will meet in closed Adjudicatory Session, and then in closed session under Mass. General Laws, chapter 112, section 65C. The Board will reconvene in Public Session II following the conclusion of the 65C Session.

Dr. Bush informed Dr. Jagella that the correspondence submitted by Dr. Jagella that was directed to Dr. Bush has been disseminated to the other Board members for their consideration.

Dr. Jagella addressed the Board regarding his reason why he believes that his license to practice medicine should be reinstated. He briefly discussed his submission to Dr. Bush that included a Supreme Court case that Dr. Jagella believed to be relevant to his matter.

Ms. Fuccione addressed the Board. She indicated that Dr. Jagella has not met his burden of proof of establishing that his reinstatement would advance the public interest. Ms. Fuccione highlighted that Dr. Jagella has not demonstrated any insight into the issues with his practice of medicine that resulted in a revocation of his license to practice medicine. She then detailed the issues with Dr. Jagella's prescribing practices that included lack of documentation and lack of follow up with patients to whom he was prescribing controlled substances.

Ms. Fuccione recommended that the Board deny Dr. Jagella's Petition for Reinstatement.

Responsive to Mr. O'Donnell's inquiry, Dr. Jagella discussed his wish to start a concierge practice of medicine because he is prohibited from participating in the Medicaid and Medicare programs.

In the **Jagella** matter, Dr. Jubbal moved to deny the Petition for Reinstatement.
