Dr. Bush informed those individuals in attendance that the Board meeting is being conducted via teleconference. Additionally, the Board meeting is being recorded by a stenographer. Under Open Meeting Law, specifically Mass. General Laws chapter 30A, section 20(f), any person who makes a video or audio recording must first notify the chair, so that the chair may notify other attendees of any recordings. Dr. Bush asked if anyone present was making a recording. One

person in attendance had his hand raised at this point, but had also previously had his hand raised before the question, and it is unclear he was responding to this question.

Introduction of David Rosenbloom, Ph.D. Public Member

George Zachos, Executive Director, stated that Dr. David Rosenbloom has been newly appointed as a Public Member to the Board of Registration in Medicine (BORIM).

David L Rosenbloom, Ph.D. is Professor Emeritus of Public Health at Boston University where he has taught and led research and community-based service programs in health policy and substance use disorders. He was principal investigator for teams that developed web-based programs to help people stop smoking (QuitNet—no longer available), to screen for excessive drinking (alcoholscreening.org), and to help veterans reduce drinking and PTSD symptoms (Vetchange.org.) He is author or co-author of more than 100 research and health policy publications. He was a member of the National Advisory Council of the NIH National Institute of Drug Abuse from Dec. 1999-Sep. 2003.

Dr. Rosenbloom was Commissioner of Health and Hospitals for the City of Boston and Chief Executive Officer of Boston City Hospital from December, 1975 to January, 1983 with responsibility for the public health delivery system, city owned hospitals, emergency services, community health centers and BCH based educational/research programs. He was President of the Health Data Institute, Lexington, MA from Dec, 1985 to Jun. 1988. The company pioneered in the analysis of medical claims data and developed several of the first generation of managed care products. He co-founded Community Medical Alliance, Boston MA, in Nov. 1989 and served as Board Chair until Mar. 1996. The company was a medical service organization that provided care on a capitated basis for people with catastrophic chronic conditions.

He served as a Board member of the Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital from Jun. 1983 to Sep. 2008 where he chaired the Building Committee for the Spaulding Charlestown Hospital project and was Board Chair from 2006-2008. He served as Board Chair for the Boston Foundation for Sight from Jul. 2017 to Dec. 2022.

He is currently a member of the Executive Committee of the Police Assisted Addiction Recovery Initiative; Board member of Stop Handgun Violence; Lay member of MA Board of Bar Overseers Disciplinary Panels; Member of the MA State Opioid Settlement Advisory Committee and Member of the Beacon Hill Village Advisory Council.

He received his PhD from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (1970) and his BA from Colgate University (1965). He was on the Faculty of Hamilton College, Clinton, NY from Sep. 1970 to Jun. 1973 and an adjunct faculty member at Brandeis University from Mar. 1981 to Dec. 1985.

The Board members introduced themselves to Dr. Rosenbloom and provided him with a brief background of their professional activities.

Dr. Rosenbloom thanked Mr. Zachos and the Members for their introductions and indicated he was looking forward to serving as a Board Member.

In so doing, the Board will discuss the reputation, character, physical condition or mental health, rather than professional competence, of a licensee, or the discipline or dismissal of, or complaints or charges against a licensee, as permitted under purpose 1 and information that may not be publicly disclosed pursuant to Mass. General Law, chapter 112, section 5 and Mass. General Law, chapter 66A, section 2, as permitted under purpose 7. The Board will also be reviewing Executive Session Minutes.

Following the Executive Session, the Board will meet in closed Adjudicatory Session, and then in closed session under Mass. General Laws, chapter 112, section 65C. The Board will reconvene in Public Session II following the conclusion of the 65C Session.
