**NOTICE OF SUSPENSION**

After a hearing on December 5, 2017, the Commission finds Agoros Bar & Grill LLC d/b/a Agoros Bar & Grill violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34C- Possession of an alcoholic beverage by a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (4 counts).

The Commission suspends the license for a period of seventeen (17) days of which seven (7) days will be served, and ten (10) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.

The suspension shall commence on Wednesday, January 24, 2018 and terminate on Tuesday, January 30, 2018. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Wednesday, January 24, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the Licensee on January 31, 2018.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 §23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form which must be signed by the Licensee and a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

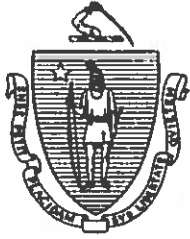
You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

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## **DECISION**

**AGOROS BAR & GRILL LLC D/B/A AGOROS BAR & GRILL

Agoros Bar & Grill LLC d/b/a Agoros Bar & Grill (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, December 5, 2017, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34C- Possession of an alcoholic beverage by a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (4 counts). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Lordan's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Lordan's Investigative Report; and
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On Thursday, March 30, 2017, at approximately 10:30 p.m., Investigators Teehan, Kenny, and Lordan ("Investigators") conducted an investigation of the business operation of Agoros Bar & Grill LLC d/b/a Agoros Bar & Grill to determine the manner in which its business was being conducted.
2. Investigators observed several youthful appearing individuals who were in possession of alcoholic beverages.
3. Investigators identified themselves and asked to see proof of legal age.

4. Underage #1, actual date of birth 1/09/1998 (age 19) was in possession of a draft beer. She stated to Investigators that she was not asked for identification.
5. Underage #2, actual date of birth 9/25/1998 (age 18) was in possession of a bottle of beer, which she quickly put down as Investigators approached. She stated that she was not asked for identification.
6. Underage #3, actual date of birth 6/23/1998 (age 18) was in possession of a vodka and cranberry [juice] mixed drink. She presented Investigators with a false South Carolina driver's license.
7. Underage #4, actual date of birth 2/28/1997 (age 20) was in possession of a vodka and cranberry [juice] mixed drink. She stated to Investigators that she had no identification with her and that she was not asked for identification.
8. While on the premises, Investigators observed approximately 25 – 30 youthful appearing individuals exiting the bar upon noticing their presence.
9. Investigators informed Jacob Scott, the security manager at the door, and Demetrius Liakos, the owner, of the violations and that a report would be filed with the Chief Investigator for further review.

#### CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34C- Possession of an alcoholic beverage by a person under twenty-one (21) years of age (4 counts). The Commission **suspends the license for a period of seventeen (17) days of which seven (7) days will be served, and ten (10) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
