DECISION

**AIR VENTURES LLC D/B/A VINEYARD GRILLE
LOGAN AIRPORT TERMINAL B UNIT 200
BOSTON, MA 02201

Air Ventures LLC d/b/a Vineyard Grille (the “Licensee”) holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the “Commission”) held a hearing on Tuesday, December 7, 2017, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Di Cicco’s Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Di Cicco’s Compliance Check Field Report; and
2. Licensee’s Stipulation of Facts.
 - A. Licensee’s Notice to Patrons of Its Carding Policy;
 - B. Results of Licensee’s Private Compliance Checks (various dates); and
 - C. Licensee’s Action Plan for Safe Service of Alcohol.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee’s record.

FACTS

1. On Tuesday, August 8, 2017, at approximately 5:21 p.m., Investigators Wilichoski and Di Cicco (“Investigators”) investigated the business Air Ventures LLC d/b/a Vineyard Grille.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Heineken beer, for six dollars and ninety-six cents (\$6.96). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, § 34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the Licensee has had no prior violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
