This is an appeal of the action of the Boston Licensing Board (the "Board") in cancelling the M.G.L. c. 138, §15 all alcoholic beverages license of Akurigu Enterprises Inc. dba 7-Eleven (the "Licensee"). The licensee timely appealed the Board's decision to the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") and a hearing was held on December 14, 2011.

1. On September 13, 2011, the Local Board held a hearing.
