This is an appeal of the action of the Boston Licensing Board ("the Board") in suspending the M.G.L. c. 138, §12 all alcoholic beverages license of Boston Bistro, Inc. dba The Breezeway (the "Licensee") for a period of two (2) weeks. The Licensee timely appealed the Board's decision to the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") and a hearing was held on June 1, 2011.

FACTS

On June 8, 2010, the Board held a hearing regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §23 and M.G.L. c. 138, §64, assault and battery patron on patron.

On June 10, 2010, the Board voted to suspend the license for two (2) weeks.

The licensee was advised by the board of the suspension in a written decision dated September 9, 2010.

The licensee appealed the decision of the board, to the ABCC, on September 20, 2010, after receiving it on September 16, 2010.

An appeal hearing was scheduled for November 10, 2010.

The appeal hearing was continued on November 3, 2010.

A new appeal hearing was set for December 15, 2010.

The December 15, 2010 appeal hearing was continued to January 26, 2011.

The January 26, 2011 appeal hearing was continued to March 16, 2011.

The March 16, 2011 appeal hearing was continued to June 1, 2011.

On June 1, 2011 the appeal hearing was held.

The licensee failed to appear at the hearing.

CONCLUSION

The appeal is dismissed without prejudice.
