DECISION

CHANSKY MARKET INC. D/B/A CHANSKY'S SUPER MARKET 1700 COMMONWEALTH AVENUE BOSTON, MA 02135

Chansky Market Inc. d/b/a Chansky's Super Market (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, October 19, 2021 regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2) Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensed stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Guarino's Report.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On Friday, October 2, 2020, at approximately 5:30 p.m., Investigators Guarino and Teehar ("Investigators"), conducted an inspection of the business operation of Chansky Marke Inc. d/b/a Chansky's Super Market to determine the manner in which its business was being conducted.
- 2. While outside the licensed premises, Investigators observed a youthful appearing male exi the market in possession of alcoholic beverages. Investigators identified themselves and asked to see proof of legal age. The male immediately stated he was 19 years old.
- 3. Underage #1, actual date of birth 3/28/2001 (age 19), was in possession of one 30-pack of Miller Lite beer and one 12-pack of White Claw Hard Seltzer.

- 4. Underage #1 informed Investigators he was asked for identification prior to purchasing the alcoholic beverages. He was asked if he did, in fact, produce an identification. He answered in the affirmative and presented to Investigators the valid New Jersey Driver's License of his older brother which he had used when purchasing the alcoholic beverages.
- 5. The Licensee has since instituted a new policy wherein all patrons are required to produce identification, regardless of age. In addition, they have purchased a new state of the art scanner to aid in evaluating identifications, specifically out of state identifications.
- 6. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2019 with two prior violations, both of which occurred within days of this incident.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count). Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for a period of three (3) days which are hereby deemed served.
