An informational hearing was held at the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") on June 12, 2013, to determine whether the Kentucky Bev Co, Inc. dba Clarendon Wine Co.'s application of requesting that the provisions of the first paragraph of section 25 of chapter 138 of the General Laws be suspended as to it for a reasonable period because the licensee was seriously damaged in its business by civil disturbance and explosion.

FACTS

- 1. On April 15, 2013, there were bombings on Boylston Street.
- 2. Kentucky Bev Co, Inc. dba Clarendon Wine Co., located at 563 Boylston Street, was a block away from the one of the primary bombing sights.
- 3. The licensed premises were part of the FBI crime scene.
- 4. As a result, the premises was closed for eight and a half days.
- 5. The premises has suffered a hardship within the meaning of M.G.L. c. 138, §25.

CONCLUSION

The Commission therefore, orders that Kentucky Bev Co, Inc. dba Clarendon Wine Co. be removed from the credit delinquency list and, if not yet posted, not be posted, for a period of twenty-one (21) days from the date of this decision.
