DECISION

HOST INTERNATIONAL INC. DBA FOX SPORTS SKYBOX TERMINAL B, LOGAN AIRPROT BOSTON, MA 02201 LICENSE#: 011602021 VIOLATION DATE: 03/20/2013 HEARD: 10/29/2013

Host International Inc. dba Fox Sports Skybox (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 29, 2013, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Temple's Report.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, March 20, 2013, at approximately 5:35 p.m., Investigators Capurso and Temple conducted an investigation of the business operation of Host International Inc. dba Fox Sports Skybox.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased an alcoholic beverage, a container of Budweiser Light beer for seven dollars and sixteen cents (\$7.16). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) Permitting an Illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138 §34 Sale or Delivery of an Alcoholic Beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the licensee has been in business for ten (10) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a WARNING.
