After a hearing on July 19, 2011, the Commission finds Game Day Pub, LLC dba Robyn's Bar and Grill in violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34C (1 count).

The Commission **suspends the licensee's license for a total of three (3) days to be served**. The suspension shall commence on **Wednesday, October 19, 2011** and terminate on **Friday, October 21, 2011**. The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Wednesday, October 19, 2011 at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee Saturday, October 22, 2011.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c.138 §23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form. All checks must be certified and accompanied by the enclosed form, which must be signed by a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.

Game Day Pub, LLC dba Robyn's Bar and Grill (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 19, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34C (1 count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jan Kujawski's report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Jan Kujawski's Report;
2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
3. MA CJIS Printout.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

**FACTS**

1. On June 30, 2011 at approximately 10:10p.m., Investigators Keefe and Kujawski investigated the business operation of Game Day Pub, LLC dba Robyn's Bar and Grill.
2. While on the licensed premises, the investigators observed a young female individual in possession of an alcoholic beverage.
3. The individual was later identified and her age was determined to be twenty (20) years of age.
4. She was observed to be in possession of a Bud Beer bottle and told the investigators that she was never asked for any form of identification when she was in the establishment.
5. The investigators informed the bartender on duty of the violation and told him that a report would be filed.

### DISCUSSION

The Investigators stated that the staff was very cooperative. The licensee, through counsel, stated that they have taken steps to make sure no further violations occur under their ownership as they are in the process of trying to sell the assets of the corporation.

### CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34C (1 count). An administrative review revealed that the licensee has one (1) prior violation one year ago in the licensee's approximate six (6) years of ownership. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for nine (9) days of which three (3) days will be served and six (6) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**


